



Dear Parishioners,

As we gather on this Third Sunday of Easter, we continue to bask in the joy and wonder of Christ's resurrection. Today's Gospel passage from Luke invites us to reflect deeply on the significance of this miraculous event and its profound implications for our lives.

In this passage, we encounter the disciples on the road to Emmaus, filled with confusion and doubt following Jesus' crucifixion. Yet, their encounter with the risen Christ transforms their sorrow into joy and their doubt into faith. Jesus appears before them, offering them peace and reassurance, and opening their minds to understand the Scriptures. Just as Jesus revealed himself to the disciples on the road to Emmaus, he continues to reveal himself to us in our lives today. He comes to us in moments of doubt, uncertainty, and despair, offering us his peace and the assurance of his presence. Like the disciples, we are called to open our hearts and minds to recognize him in the midst of our everyday experiences.



May this Easter season be a time of renewal and transformation for each one of us, as we embrace the resurrected life that Christ offers us.

Jesus' Body Came Back to Life!




When Jesus rose from the dead, was He just a spirit or did He have a real living body?






