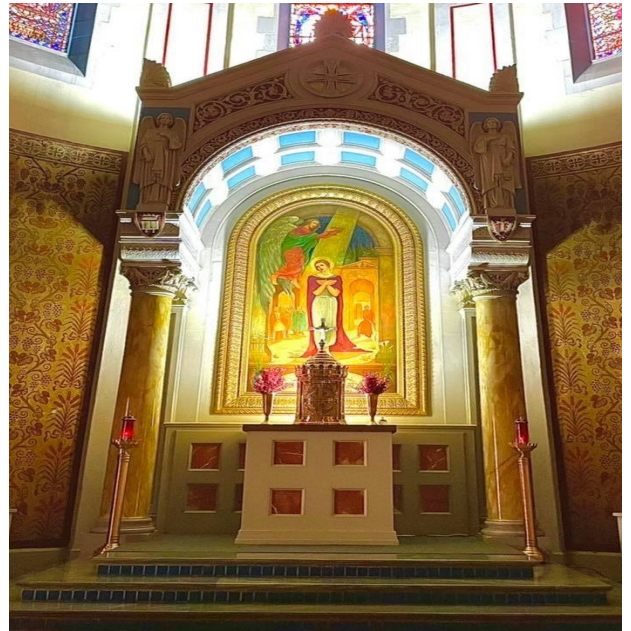

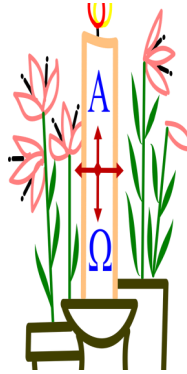

Let's embrace our gifts, no matter how small, and use them to make a positive impact in the world. By doing so, we participate in God's transformative work of love and compassion.

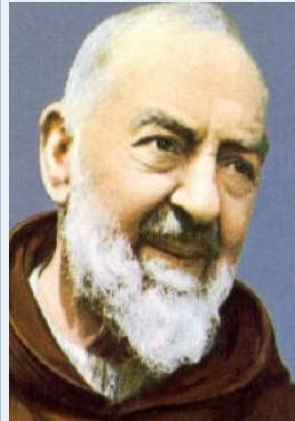
A great way to embrace your gifts is to join the Parish Choir! We are in a great need of more voices! Please join!

Some people have many talents and can do lots of good things. Other people can only do a few things well. But no matter what you can do, God wants you to do your best.



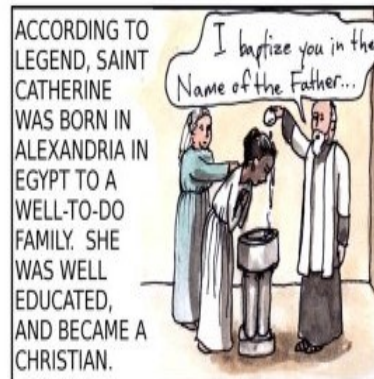

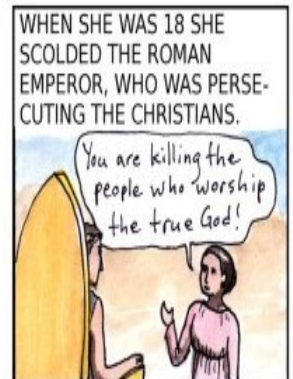
Answers to front page: The first man had ten, the second had four and the third man one.

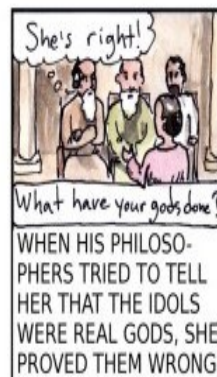
Saint Catherine of Alexandria November 25

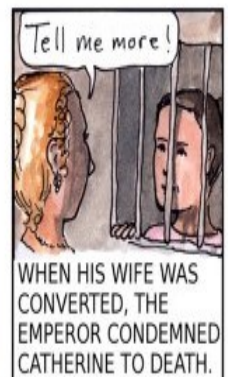

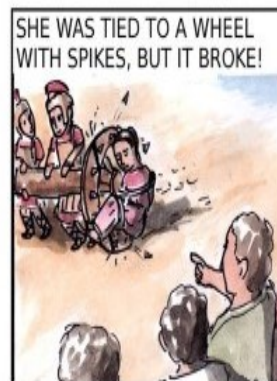

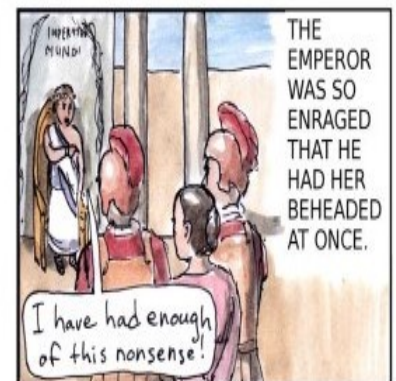

Father in Heaven, Creator of all and source of all goodness and love, please look kindly upon us and receive our heartfelt gratitude in this time of giving thanks.

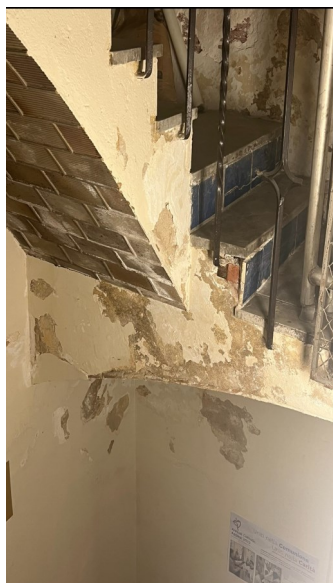
