

Dear Parishioners,

Today, on the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity, we are invited to contemplate the mystery of God's triune nature and to reflect on the profound implications it has for our lives as disciples of Jesus Christ. In the Gospel reading today from Matthew, commonly known as the Great Commission, Jesus commissions his disciples to go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

This passage encapsulates the essence of our Trinitarian faith. We worship one God in three Persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—distinct yet inseparable. The Trinity reveals to us the communal nature of God, characterized by perfect unity, love, and relationship. As we ponder this mystery, we are invited into a deeper relationship with the Triune God, who invites us to share in the divine life of love and communion.

The Great Commission underscores the mission of the Church, which is rooted in the very life of the Trinity. We are called to go forth and proclaim the Gospel to all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. This mission is not merely a human endeavor but a participation in God's own mission of reconciliation and redemption.


As we celebrate the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity, let us be mindful of our baptismal call to be disciples of Jesus Christ. Let us embrace our identity as children of God, called to live in communion with the Trinity and to bear witness to the love of God in our words and actions. Let us also seek to deepen our understanding of the mystery of the Trinity through prayer, study, and reflection, knowing that we will never fully comprehend it but that our efforts to do so draw us closer to God.




GOD, THE HOLY TRINITY

Trinity puzzle: Each Person IS NOT any other Person, but each Person IS GOD



Here is a puzzle that might help you understand the Holy Trinity a little better. Use the letter code at the bottom to fill in the blanks.


