





As we gather together in celebration of the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, we are reminded of the profound mystery and gift of the Eucharist. In today's Gospel from Mark we hear the account of the Last Supper, where Jesus institutes the sacrament of the Eucharist.

In this passage, Jesus instructs His disciples to make preparations for the Passover meal, and during the meal, He takes bread, blesses it, breaks it, and gives it to them, saying, "Take it; this is my body." He then takes the cup, gives thanks, and gives it to them, saying, "This is my blood of the covenant, which will be shed for many."

Through these words and actions, Jesus establishes the Eucharist as a memorial of His sacrifice for our salvation. In receiving the Body and Blood of Christ in the Eucharist, we are united with Him in a profound way. It is through this sacrament that we are nourished spiritually, strengthened in our faith, and brought into communion with one another as members of the Body of Christ.



The Body and Blood of Our Lord

Today we celebrate the feast of the Body and Blood of Our Lord in the Holy Eucharist.

At the Last Supper, Jesus changed bread and wine into His own Body and Blood. He has the power to do this because He is God. He did this because He wanted to stay with us even after He died and went into Heaven.

Jesus comes to us in every Mass.


The priest takes the place of Jesus, saying the words that Jesus said at the Last Supper, and the bread and wine become the real Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus even though they still look like bread and wine.

How do I receive Communion well?

- 1. Be ready! Think about what is going to happen. Make sure that you don't have any big sins on your soul. If you do, then go to confession first.
- 2. Don't eat or drink anything other than water or medicine for an hour before going to Holy Communion.
 This is a sign of respect for Our Lord.
- 3. After receiving Holy Communion, take some time to thank Jesus for coming to you and talk to Him. He is your best friend and loves spending time with you!
