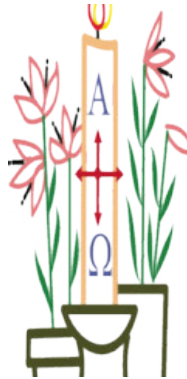

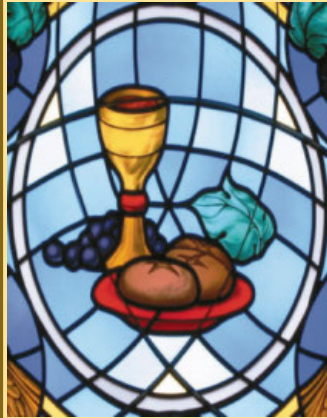

## The Music Ministry of St. Pancras

Dear Parishioners,

Today as we gather on this 13th Sunday in Ordinary Time, the Gospel passage from Mark presents us with two poignant stories of healing and restoration – the healing of the woman with a hemorrhage and the raising of Jairus' daughter. These narratives serve as powerful demonstrations of Jesus' compassion, power, and authority over sickness and death.

In the first story, we witness the touching encounter between Jesus and the woman who had been suffering from a hemorrhage for twelve years. Despite her physical ailment and social isolation, the woman's faith in Jesus compels her to reach out and touch His cloak, believing that even the slightest connection to Him could bring healing. Jesus, recognizing her faith, commends her and grants her complete restoration.

The story of Jairus' daughter further illustrates Jesus' ability to bring life where there is death. Despite the apparent finality of the girl's passing, Jesus demonstrates His power over death by raising her to life, restoring hope and joy to her family.

These narratives call us to reflect on our own response to God's call in our lives. Like the woman with the hemorrhage and Jairus, we are invited to approach Jesus with faith, trust, and humility, knowing that He is able to heal our wounds, both physical and spiritual, and bring new life to what was once lost.

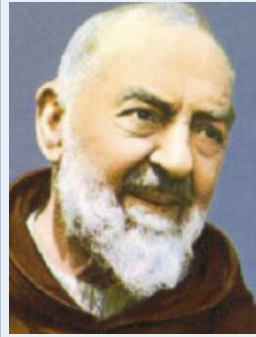
As we meditate on these stories of healing and restoration, let us be reminded of Jesus' unfailing love and compassion for each of us. Let us respond to His call with faith and courage, knowing that He is always ready to meet us in our moments of need and bring about miraculous transformations in our lives.

May these Gospel accounts inspire us to reach out to Jesus in faith, to trust in His healing power, and to embrace the new life He offers us. May we heed His call to follow Him with all our hearts and experience the abundant blessings He has in store for us.

### When People are Sick...

In today's Gospel reading we hear about Jesus curing the sick. Jesus wants us to follow His example and care for the sick and dying. But we can't do miracles like Jesus did!

What can we do?

Here are some ideas:



1. If someone in your family is sick, maybe you can help them out! Ask if you could read them a story, or help them by bringing them anything they need. A 'Get Well' card would be nice too!



2. Always pray for people who are sick. Your prayers can help them get better, or they might help your sick friend to understand why God is letting them suffer.

What about when you are sick? When you are sick or hurt, think about Jesus suffering on the cross. Offer your pain to Him and tell Him that you want to suffer with Him so that people will be saved from their sins. Be thankful for people who help you when you are sick. Remember, they take Jesus' place!

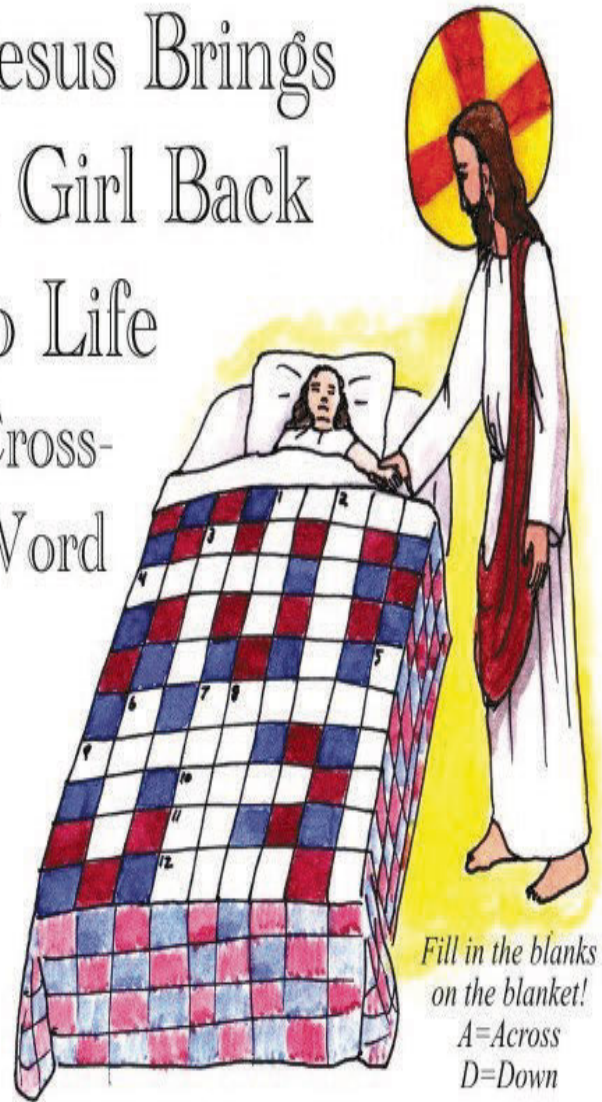

## Jesus Brings a Girl Back to Life

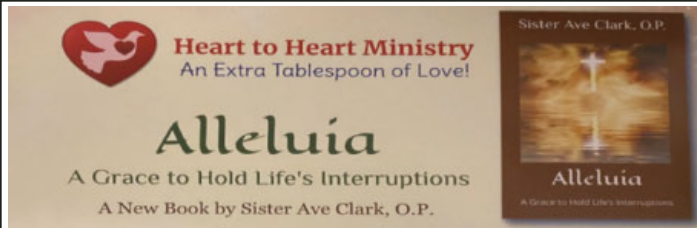

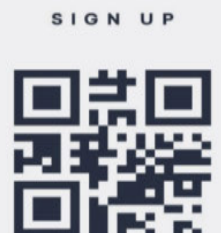

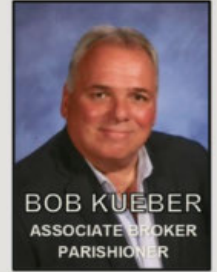
