





Dear Parishioners,

In this Sunday's Gospel from Mark, we meet a rich young man who approaches Jesus with an earnest question: "What must I do to inherit eternal life?" He seems sincere and devout, for he has kept the commandments. Yet, Jesus sees deeper into his heart. Jesus tells him, "Go, sell what you have, and give to the poor... then come, follow me." These words strike at the core of the man's security—his wealth. Saddened by the challenge, he walks away, unwilling to part with his possessions.

This encounter can resonate with each of us. While we may not have great wealth, we often hold on to things that we consider essential: our comfort, reputation, or even our own sense of control. These attachments, however, can become obstacles that prevent us from fully following Christ.

Jesus reminds us that the way to eternal life is not merely about keeping the rules, but about letting go of everything that keeps us from trusting entirely in God. It is about freeing ourselves from the illusion that we can secure our own future. The disciples, too, are taken aback, wondering, "Who then can be saved?" Jesus' response offers hope: "For human beings it is impossible, but not for God. All things are possible for God."


We are called to examine what holds us back in our own journey of discipleship. What are the "possessions" in our lives that we struggle to let go of? How can we open our hearts to rely more fully on God's grace? Jesus invites us to trust that when we surrender, we don't lose—we gain everything. As He promises, "No one who has left house or brothers or sisters... for my sake and for the sake of the gospel will not receive a hundred times more."

This week, let's reflect on how we can respond to Jesus' call with courage. May we learn to trust that God's plan for us is far greater than anything we could ever possess. Let's take that step of faith, knowing that when we follow Christ, we receive the greatest treasure of all—eternal life in Him.




