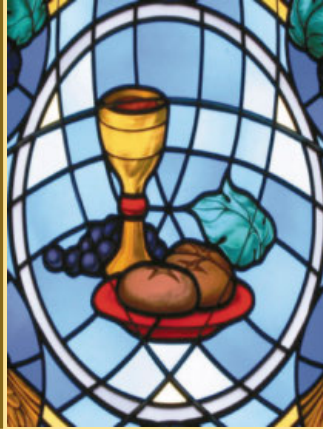

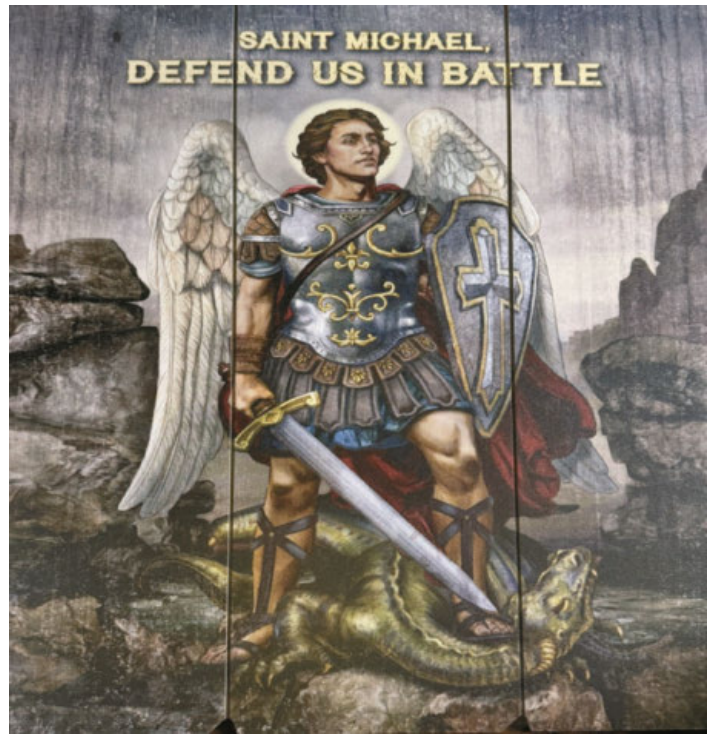

## Church News

Dear Parishioners,

Today we hear from the Gospel of Mark. In this Gospel passage we witness an all-too-human moment from two of Jesus' disciples, James and John. They ask Jesus for a privileged position in His glory: "Grant that in your glory we may sit one at your right and the other at your left." Their request is bold, but it also reveals their misunderstanding of what it means to follow Christ.

Jesus responds with both a challenge and a lesson. He asks, "Can you drink the cup that I drink or be baptized with the baptism with which I am baptized?" James and John, not fully grasping the depth of His words, say they can. Jesus' "cup" and "baptism" point to His suffering and self-sacrifice. Following Jesus means embracing the path of servanthood, not seeking honor or power.

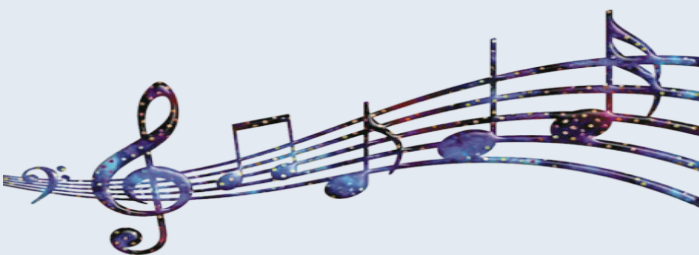
When the other disciples hear of this conversation, they are indignant, likely because they also desire the same kind of status. But Jesus gathers them together and gives a profound teaching on what true greatness in the Kingdom of God looks like: "Whoever wishes to be great among you will be your servant; whoever wishes to be first among you will be the slave of all."

In a world that often equates greatness with power, success, and influence, Jesus flips the script. He shows that true greatness is found not in being served, but in serving others. Jesus Himself provides the ultimate example, saying, "For the Son of Man did not come to be served but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many."

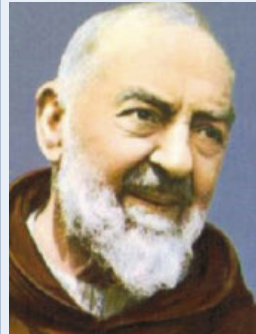
This Gospel invites us to reconsider our own ambitions and motivations. Are we seeking status, recognition, or influence in our lives? Or are we focused on serving others with humility, as Jesus did? In our families, workplaces, and communities, we are called to follow His example of self-giving love. It is through service that we become truly great in God's eyes.

Let's reflect on how we can embody this call to servanthood. How can we, in small ways and large, put the needs of others ahead of our own desires for recognition? As we strive to live out this Gospel message, we are reminded that in giving of ourselves, we find true fulfillment and participate in the greatness of God's Kingdom.

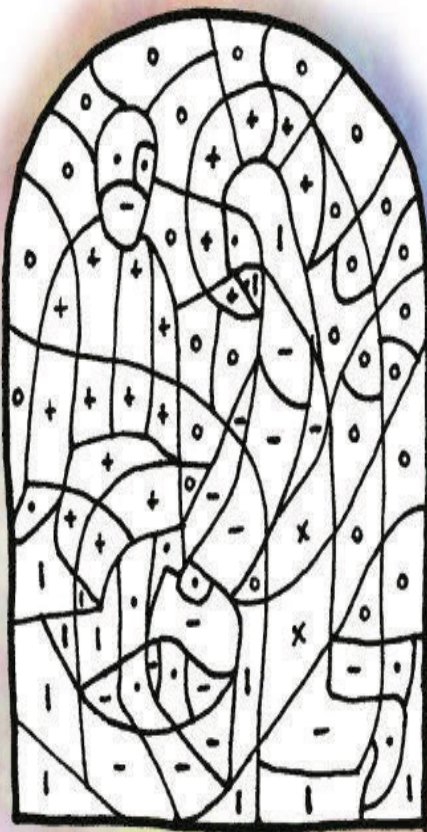

## Great People Serve Others!

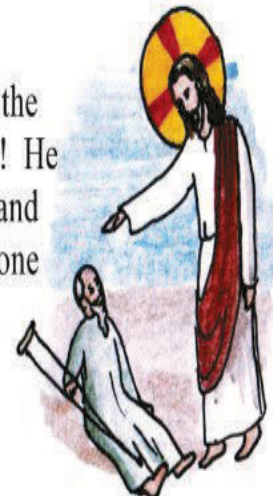
In today's Gospel reading, Jesus tells us that the people who are really great are those who serve. Here are some really great people:
