Have you ever been to the home of a Jewish friend and seen the small box positioned in the doorway frame? It contains the words of the "Shema" which we hear in today's

readings. The Book of Deuteronomy says that God's people are to keep these words even on the doorposts of their homes as a reminder that they are words to live by:

"Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength."

Jesus says these words are the first and greatest commandment They begin with a call to listen—"Hear, O Israel." It's a reminder that our faith starts with attentive listening to God's word.

This isn't just a casual reminder. It is a way of life. Listening to God's voice, His Word, in everything we do. We are to talk about it with our children, reflect on it in our homes, and let it guide our actions and decisions. It's a call to make God's love the central theme of our existence.

That's why Jesus says the second greatest commandment - to love our neighbor - is like the first. Our love for God must naturally flow into love for others.

Are we listening attentively to God's word? Are we loving Him with all our heart, soul, and strength? Are we letting this love influence every aspect of our lives?


This week let's be challenged to live the commandment to love, God and one another in whatever way that challenge presents itself to us.




