

The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord

On February 2nd, we celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, also known as Candlemas Day. This significant day marks an ancient tradition that commemorates the presentation of Jesus in the Temple forty days after His birth. According to the Gospel of Luke (Luke 2:22-40), Mary and Joseph brought baby Jesus to the Temple in Jerusalem to present Him to the Lord, fulfilling the Jewish law of the time.



The Tradition of Blessing Candles

This feast is also known as Candlemas because of the age-old custom of blessing candles during the Mass. The blessed candles are symbolic of Jesus Christ, who is referred to as the "Light of the World." The tradition of blessing candles can be traced back to the early centuries of the Church. These candles, once blessed, are often used throughout the year in homes and churches, especially in times of prayer and reflection.


A Symbol of Light and Faith

Blessed candles illuminate not just our homes, but our spiritual paths, reminding us of the presence of Christ among us.

We invite everyone to Mass on February 2nd for a special blessing. Mass will begin at 7:00 PM in the vestibule of the church and we will process into the church.

At this Mass, we will honor our Religious Sisters in Celebration of the World Day for Consecrated Life.

Dear Parishioners,

In today's Gospel, Jesus Christ goes up the mountain and sits down. That detail matters. In Scripture, mountains are places of encounter, where God reveals himself and speaks with authority. What follows are not suggestions or poetic ideals. The Beatitudes are the charter of the Kingdom of Heaven.

At first hearing, they sound upside down. The poor in spirit are blessed. Those who mourn are blessed. The meek, the merciful, the persecuted are called happy. Jesus is not romanticizing suffering. He is revealing where God is already at work. Blessedness is not tied to power, comfort, or applause. It is rooted in trust, humility, and fidelity to God even when it costs something.

Each Beatitude points to a way of living that frees the heart. Poverty of spirit loosens our grip on control. Meekness refuses revenge. Mercy breaks cycles of resentment. Purity of heart simplifies our loves. Peacemakers refuse to reduce others to enemies. None of this comes naturally. All of it is learned by staying close to Christ.

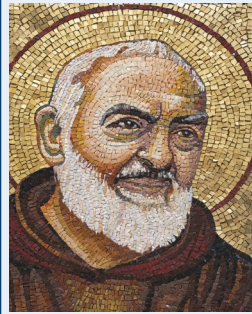
For a parish community, the Beatitudes are both a mirror and a mission. They ask us who we welcome, how we forgive, and where we place our security. They also remind us that holiness often looks ordinary and hidden. The Kingdom grows quietly in hearts shaped by mercy, patience, and courage.

This week, choose one Beatitude and live it intentionally. Not perfectly, just honestly. In doing so, we stand on the mountain with Christ and begin to see the world as God sees it.

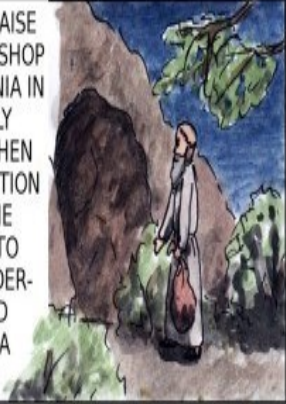

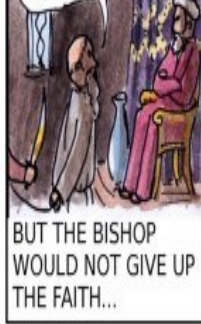

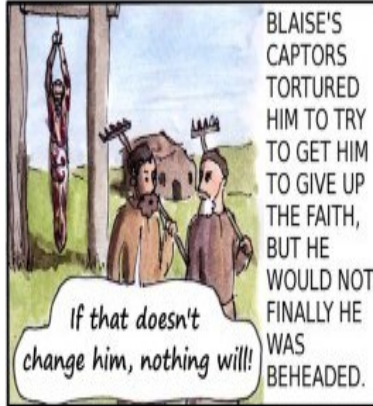
