Lenten Regulations

Abstinence: Those who have reached the age of 14 are required to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.

Fasting: Those between the ages of 18 to 59 are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday. Fasting means limiting oneself to one full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may be taken on two other occasions during the day. Coffee, tea and juice are permitted at any time.

Easter Duty: After they have been fully initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, all the faithful are bound to receive Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept must be fulfilled in the Easter Season unless, by good reason, it is fulfilled at another time.

Music Ministry

Dear Parishioners,

Today's readings revolve around a theme we often resist hearing clearly: we are responsible for our choices.

Sirach puts it bluntly. God sets before us fire and water life and death. We are not puppets and we are not trapped by fate. God gives commandments not as burdens but as a real invitation to choose life. Freedom is not doing whatever we want. True freedom is choosing what leads us closer to God.

Saint Paul deepens this by reminding us that God's wisdom is not obvious at first glance. The wisdom of the world tells us to look for shortcuts exceptions and technicalities. God's wisdom reaches deeper. It is revealed slowly to hearts that are willing to listen and trust. What God prepares for those who love him cannot be seen with the eyes alone. It must be received with humility.

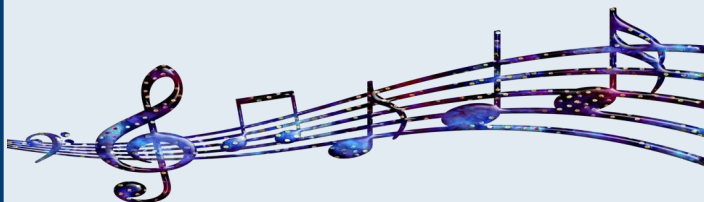
That sets the stage for the Gospel. Jesus makes it clear that he has not come to relax the law or lower the bar. He fulfills it. Then he does something far more challenging than adding rules. He moves the focus from outward compliance to the inner life of the heart.

It is not enough to avoid murder if anger rules us. It is not enough to avoid adultery if we treat others as objects. It is not enough to speak truth occasionally if our everyday speech is careless or manipulative. Jesus calls us to integrity. To be whole. To let our inner lives match our outward actions.

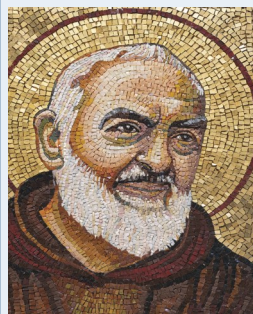
This Gospel can feel overwhelming because it leaves no room to hide behind technical obedience. But it is also hopeful. Jesus believes that with God's grace our hearts can actually be changed. Holiness is not about perfection. It is about honesty before God and a willingness to let him reshape our desires.

As we gather for the Eucharist today we bring with us our choices both good and bad. We ask for the wisdom promised to those who love God and the courage to choose life again and again starting in the heart.

Ash Wednesday



This coming Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, which is the first day of Lent. Lent is a special time in which we prepare to celebrate Jesus' death and resurrection on Good Friday and Easter Sunday.



Lent is a time of repentance. We make sacrifices and try to improve our lives to become more like Jesus. Jesus never sinned but He gave up His life to pay for our sins. That is why we make sacrifices—out of love for God and to make up for our sins. We offer our sacrifices to God the Father, just as Jesus on the cross offered up His life to God the Father.

On Ash Wednesday if you go to Mass you can receive ashes on your forehead. The ashes are a sign of repentance. They remind us that without God we are nothing and that someday we will die and be buried. But they can also remind us that if we do have God living in us, after we die we will rise from the dead, just as Jesus did on Easter, after He died on the cross.

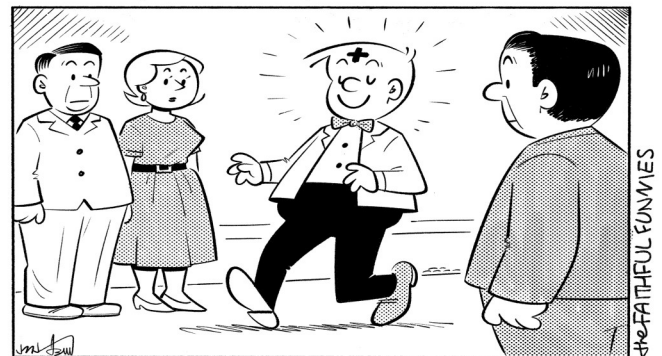
