Lenten Regulations

Abstinence: Those who have reached the age of 14 are required to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.

Fasting: Those between the ages of 18 to 59 are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday. Fasting means limiting oneself to one full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may be taken on two other occasions during the day. Coffee, tea and juice are permitted at any time.

Easter Duty: After they have been fully initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, all the faithful are bound to receive Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept must be fulfilled in the Easter Season unless, by good reason, it is fulfilled at another time.

Music Ministry

Dear Parishioners,

The Second Sunday of Lent gives us a glimpse of where this long road is leading. Lent is often marked by ashes, fasting, and self denial, but today the Church lifts the veil for just a moment and lets us see the glory that lies ahead.

In the Gospel, Jesus leads Peter, James, and John up the mountain. There, they witness the Transfiguration. Christ shines with divine light. Moses and Elijah appear. The voice of the Father is heard: "This is my beloved Son. Listen to him." It is overwhelming, beautiful, and holy. And just as quickly as it comes, it is gone. Jesus leads them back down the mountain, toward Jerusalem, toward the Cross.

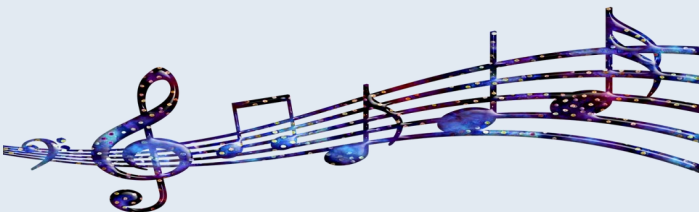
That pattern runs through all the readings. Abram is told to leave everything familiar behind and trust in God's promise, even though the destination is unknown. Paul reminds Timothy that God's saving plan was not earned but revealed, and that following Christ includes hardship as well as hope. The mountain moments are real, but they are not permanent. They are given to strengthen us for the journey.

That is an important lesson for Lent. We do not pray, fast, and sacrifice simply to feel better or to have a spiritual "high." We do these things so that when life becomes heavy, when faith feels costly, we remember who Jesus is and why we follow him. The Transfiguration reminds us that the Cross is not the end of the story.

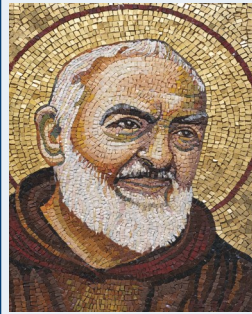
Peter wanted to stay on the mountain and build tents. Who wouldn't? But discipleship does not allow us to stay where it is comfortable. We are called to listen to Christ, follow him back down into daily life, and trust that the glory we glimpse now will one day be complete.

This week, Lent invites us to keep climbing, even when the path feels steep, and to keep listening, especially when the voice of Christ challenges us. The light is real. The promise is sure. And the journey, though difficult, leads to glory.

Jesus Shows His Glory

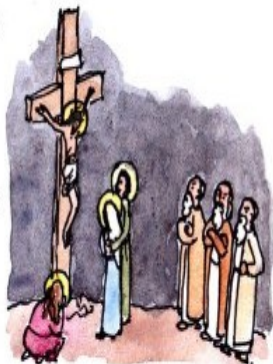


In today's Gospel reading Jesus took three of His apostles up a mountain and gave them a vision of His true glory. He shone as bright as the sun- so bright they could hardly look at Him. But did you know that what they saw was only a tiny bit of the true glory of God?

It was so beautiful that Peter wanted Him to stay that way. He offered to build tents for Jesus and Moses and Elijah, who appeared with Him. But the joy of that moment wasn't meant to last forever. It was just a little taste of Heaven.

Jesus gave this experience to the three apostles just a little while before He went to Jerusalem to suffer and die on the cross. He knew that they would be terrified and very sad when He died so He gave them a preview of the glory He would go back to after He rose from the dead. That way they knew they had a reason to hope even when He was killed.

Sometimes we have awful things to suffer through too. Maybe a friend will move away or one of our grandparents will die. But we never have to give up hope because we know that eventually everyone who loves Jesus will live in total happiness in Heaven.

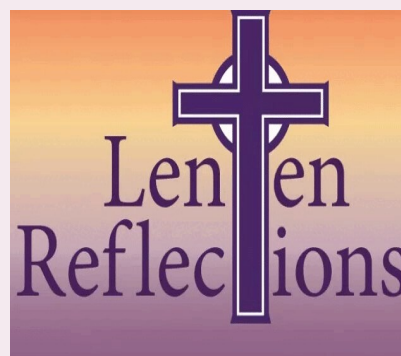
