Music Ministry

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday is all about sight. Not the kind that depends on perfect vision or sharp eyes, but the kind that sees with the heart.

In the first reading, God sends Samuel to anoint a new king. Jesse lines up his sons, and naturally the strongest and most impressive come first. Yet God stops Samuel short. The Lord does not see as we see. Human beings look at appearance, but God looks at the heart. The chosen one is David, the youngest, overlooked, still out-tending sheep. God's light falls where no one expects it.

That same theme carries into the Gospel, where Jesus encounters a man blind from birth. The disciples want an explanation. Who sinned. Who is to blame. Jesus refuses the premise. This is not about fault. This is about God's work being revealed. As Jesus heals the man, physical sight is restored, but something deeper happens too. The man grows in faith step by step, while those who claim to see most clearly grow more blind.

Jesus declares, "I am the light of the world," and that light exposes more than darkness. It reveals truth. The Pharisees are certain of their knowledge, certain of their righteousness, and certain they already see. Yet they cannot recognize the work of God standing in front of them. The formerly blind man, on the other hand, sees clearly enough to believe.

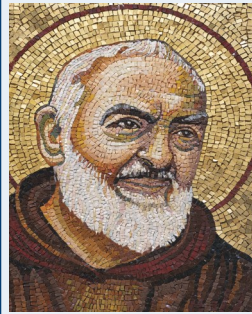
Saint Paul makes the message unmistakable in the second reading. Once you were darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Live as children of light. Light produces goodness, righteousness, and truth. It also demands honesty. It forces us to ask where we might be clinging to comfort, certainty, or pride instead of trusting God's vision.

Laetare Sunday gives us a pause of joy in the middle of Lent, but it is not a break from conversion. It is an invitation. Let Christ shine light into places we may prefer to keep dim. Let Him challenge what we think we know. Like David, like the man born blind, may we be humble enough to be chosen, healed, and sent forth seeing more clearly than before.

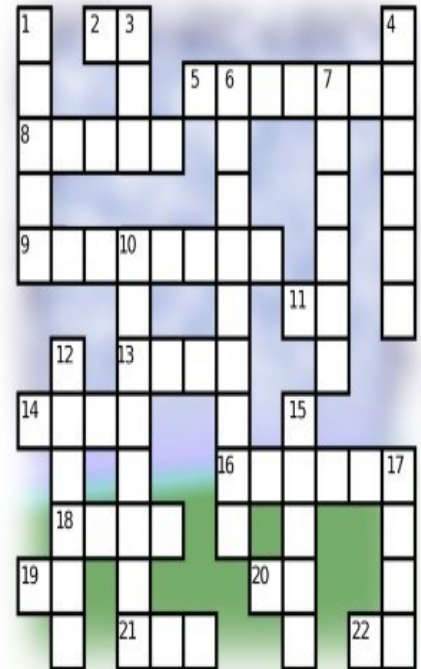

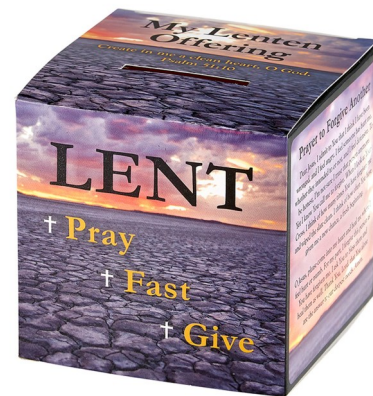

Lenten Regulations

Abstinence: Those who have reached the age of 14 are required to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent.

Fasting: Those between the ages of 18 to 59 are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday. Fasting means limiting oneself to one full meal and avoiding food between meals. Light sustenance may be taken on two other occasions during the day. Coffee, tea and juice are permitted at any time.

Easter Duty: After they have been fully initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, all the faithful are bound to receive Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept must be fulfilled in the Easter Season unless, by good reason, it is fulfilled at another time.
