Music Ministry

Dear Parishioners,

By the Fifth Sunday of Lent, the Church is no longer subtle. The readings are blunt, even unsettling. Graves are opened. Bodies rise. Jesus stands before death itself and calls it out.

Ezekiel hears the Lord promise, "I will open your graves and have you rise." This is not poetic comfort. It is a declaration that God is not finished with what looks finished. Exile, loss, failure, even death itself do not get the final word. God does.

Psalms 130 gives us the human response to that promise. We cry "out of the depths." We wait. We hope. This is not shallow optimism. It is hope learned the hard way, hope that has stared into darkness and still chooses to trust.

Saint Paul takes it further. The Spirit who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you. Not someday. Not later. Now. Resurrection is not only about the end of time. It is already at work in us, even when we feel spiritually tired, stuck, or lifeless.

And then we arrive at Bethany.

John gives us one of the most human moments in all of Scripture. Jesus weeps. He does not rush past grief. He does not scold Martha and Mary for their sorrow. He stands with them in it. Only then does he speak the words that anchor this entire season of Lent:

"I am the resurrection and the life."

Before Lazarus walks out of the tomb, Jesus asks for faith. Not perfect faith. Not confident faith. Just enough to believe that death does not define the story.

This Gospel is not only about Lazarus. It is about the places in our own lives that feel sealed shut. Habits we think will never change. Relationships we assume are beyond repair. Faith that feels buried under disappointment or routine. Jesus stands before those tombs too and says, "Come out."

Lent is almost over. The Church is preparing us for Easter, but not cheaply. Resurrection only comes after we admit where we are dead and where we need saving.

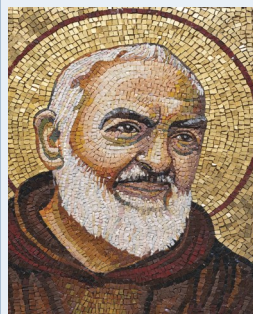
If you feel worn down, discouraged, or spiritually numb, this Gospel is for you. Christ does not avoid those places. He enters them. He weeps with us. And then he calls us to life.

The stone can be rolled away. The grave does not win.
