# Alleluia!

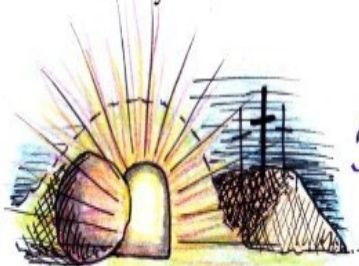

JESUS IS ALIVE!*

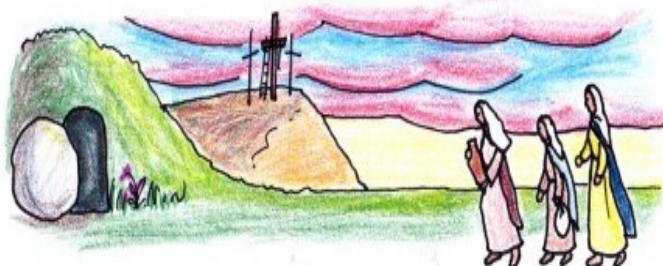

Christ is Risen! Alleluia!

On this glorious Easter Sunday, we rejoice in the triumph of our Lord Jesus Christ over sin and death. As Pope John Paul II proclaimed in his Easter messages, the Resurrection is the victory of Life over death, a cosmic turning point that fills our hearts with unshakable hope and joyful peace "Christ is risen!"—this cry echoes through the ages, from the empty tomb to our parishes today, calling us to a new life in Him.

In a world often shadowed by trials, the Risen Christ invites us to be witnesses of His love, sowing hope and reconciliation wherever we go. Let the light of Easter renew our families, our community, and our commitment to the Gospel. Emerge from Lent transformed, living as "living stones" in the Church, built on the cornerstone of the Resurrection.
