

What is a Shrine?

A shrine in church is a dedicated place of prayer and devotion to help us draw closer to God through a saint's example and intercession. In our church, there are several places for this: We have places to honor Padre Pio, Our Lady of Czestochowa, Our Lady of Guadalupe and Saint Pancras. Places where we can pause, light a candle, and pray quietly for intentions. They remind us that the saints are our friends in heaven, close to us and interceding for us before the Lord. In our parish we will have such an area in honor of Saint Carlo Acutis, a young layman who used his love of the Eucharist and his gifts with computers to help others know Jesus more deeply. He has become a powerful patron for young people in our time, showing that holiness is possible in ordinary, modern life. The shrine will feature a mosaic image of Saint Carlo and will be located across from the existing shrine of Saint Pancras (another patron of youth).

This new shrine will include a special 4 piece Relic of Saint Carlo Acutis which has been specially given to our parish by his mother, through Cardinal Raymond Burke.

A relic fosters closeness to our saint.

Because of this special gift, Cardinal Burke will come to our parish to bless the new mosaic image and the shrine. His presence underscores that this is not simply a decoration, but a true place of grace and pilgrimage where many can come to renew their faith.

To mark this occasion, there will be a special Mass on Sunday, May 10 at 3:30 PM, during which the new shrine of Saint Carlo Acutis will be blessed. Following the Mass, **everyone is invited to a reception in the parish garden, where you will have the opportunity to meet Cardinal Burke personally.**

Un santuario en la iglesia es un lugar dedicado a la oración y la devoción para ayudarnos a acercarnos a Dios mediante el ejemplo de los Santos y su intercesión. En nuestra iglesia hay varios lugares para esto: Tenemos lugares para honrar al Padre Pío, Nuestra Señora de Czestochowa, Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe y San Pancracio. Lugares donde podemos detenernos, encender una vela y rezar en silencio. Estos lugares, nos recuerdan que los santos son nuestros amigos en el cielo, que están cerca de nosotros e intercediendo por nosotros ante el Señor. En nuestra parroquia tendremos un lugar en honor a San Carlo Acutis, un joven laico que utilizó su amor por la Eucaristía y sus dones con los computadores para ayudar a otros a conocer más profundamente a Jesús. Se ha convertido en un poderoso mecenas para los jóvenes de nuestro tiempo, demostrando que la santidad es posible en la vida cotidiana y moderna. El santuario contará con una imagen en mosaico de San Carlos y estará situado frente al santuario existente de San Pancracio (otro patrón de la juventud). Este nuevo santuario incluirá una reliquia de San Carlos Acutis que ha sido entregada especialmente a nuestra parroquia por su madre, a través del cardenal Raymond Burke. Una reliquia fomenta la cercanía con nuestro santo. Gracias a este regalo especial, el cardenal Burke vendrá a nuestra parroquia para bendecir el mosaico y el santuario. Su presencia subraya que esto no es simplemente una decoración, sino un verdadero lugar de gracia y peregrinación donde muchos pueden venir a renovar su fe. Para conmemorar esta ocasión, habrá una misa especial el domingo 10 de mayo a las 3:30 pm, durante la cual será bendecido el nuevo santuario de San Carlos Acutis. Después de la misa, todos están invitados a una recepción en el Jardín parroquial, donde tendrán la oportunidad de conocer personalmente al cardenal Burke.

Drodzy Parafianie,

W naszym kościele jest kilka takich miejsc, które są poświęcone modlitwie i nabożeństwu, pomagają one zbliżyć się do Boga poprzez przykład i wstawiennictwo świętych. Mamy miejsca poświęcone Ojcu Pio, Matce Bożej Częstochowskiej, Matce Bożej z Guadalupe oraz św. Pankracemu. Możemy się tam zatrzymać, zapalić świece i pomodlić się w naszych intencjach w ciszy i skupieniu. Przypominają nam one, że święci są naszymi przyjaciółmi w niebie, są nam bliscy i wstawiają się za nami przed Panem Bogiem. Nasza parafia staje się teraz również takim miejscem, miejscem kultu św. Carlo Acutis. Młodego świeckiego chłopca, który wykorzystał całą swoją miłość do Eucharystii oraz swoje umiejętności komputerowe, aby pomagać innym lepiej poznać Jezusa. Carlo stał się szczególnym patronem młodych ludzi naszych czasów, pokazując, że świętość jest możliwa w zwyczajnym, współczesnym życiu.

W bocznym ołtarzu, nas ego kościoła znajdzie się mozaikowy wizerunek św. Carlo, który zostanie umieszczony naprzeciw istniejącego ołtarza św. Pankracego, także patrona młodzieży. Obok mozaiki będzie również relikwia św. Carlo Acutis, którą nasza parafia otrzymała jako szczególny dar od jego matki, za pośrednictwem kardynała Raymonda Burke'a. Relikwia ta pomoże nam w budowaniu duchowej bliskości ze świętym. Dzięki temu wyjątkowemu wydarzeniu, kardynał Raymond Burke, przybędzie do naszej parafii, aby poświęcić nową mozaikę z wizerunkiem św. Carlo Acutis i relikwię. Obecność relikwii podkreśla, że nie jest to jedynie ozdoba, lecz prawdziwe miejsce łaski i pielgrzymowania, gdzie wielu wiernych może przyjść, aby odnowić swoją wiarę.

Z tej okazji odbędzie się uroczysta Msza Święta w niedzielę, 10 maja o godzinie 15:30. Bardzo serdecznie zapraszamy wszystkich wiernych na tę uroczystość oraz na przyjęcie, które odbędzie zaraz po Mszy świętej w ogrodzie parafialnym. Będzie również okazja, by w tym czasie spotkać się z kardynałem Burke. Bardzo prosimy o poinformowanie nas, czy planują Państwo uczestniczyć w tym wydarzeniu i o skontaktowanie się z biurem parafialnym. Music Ministry

Dear Parishioners,

The Fourth Sunday of Easter is often called Good Shepherd Sunday, and the reason is clear. Every reading points us to Christ as the one who leads, protects, and calls us by name. In the Gospel, Jesus speaks plainly: "My sheep hear my voice... and they follow me." This is not just poetic language. It describes a real relationship. The Christian life is not simply about rules or routines. It is about recognizing a voice and choosing to follow it.

In the first reading, the people are cut to the heart when they hear Peter preach. They ask the most important question a person can ask: "What are we to do?" Peter's answer is direct. Repent, be baptized, and receive the Holy Spirit. In other words, listen to the voice of the Shepherd and respond. That moment of conviction is not something to ignore. It is the Shepherd calling. When they respond, thousands are brought into new life. The same is true today. Christ still calls, and hearts are still moved. The question is whether we are willing to respond.

The Gospel adds another layer. Jesus says that his sheep recognize his voice and will not follow a stranger. That raises an important question for us. Whose voice are we actually following? There are many voices in our world that compete for our attention. They promise life but often lead us away from it. The voice of Christ leads us through the gate. It may not always be the easiest path, but it is the one that leads to true freedom and lasting peace.

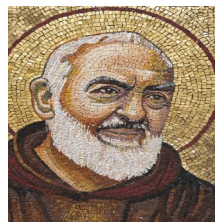
The second reading reminds us what following the Shepherd looks like. It means walking in his footsteps, even when it involves suffering or sacrifice. Christ did not respond to insult with insult. He trusted the Father completely. This is the path of those who belong to him. It is a life marked by patience, trust, and healing. This Sunday invites us to listen more carefully. The Shepherd is still speaking. He calls each of us by name. The real question is whether we are listening and ready to follow.

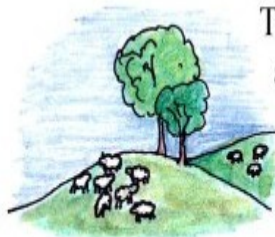

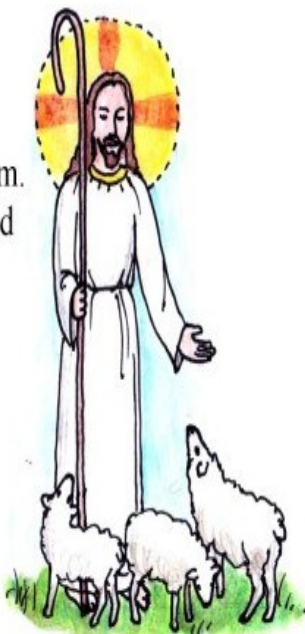
The Good Shepherd



The readings in today's Mass talk about Jesus the Good Shepherd. In Jesus' time, and still in some parts of the world today, there would be flocks of sheep grazing in the pastures. The shepherds were the people who looked after the flocks and made sure none of the sheep got lost or hurt or attacked by wild animals.

The Church is the flock of Jesus, and He is the Good Shepherd. He guides the people in the Church so that their souls will not be hungry- He gives us grace, just like a shepherd makes sure his sheep have lots of grass to eat!

Like the shepherd protects the sheep from danger, Our Lord also protects us from harm. In the "Our Father" we ask God to deliver us from evil. When our souls are hurt by sin, the Good Shepherd heals us with forgiveness in Confession.



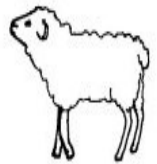

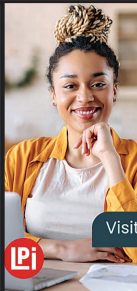
