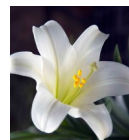

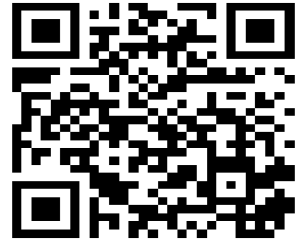

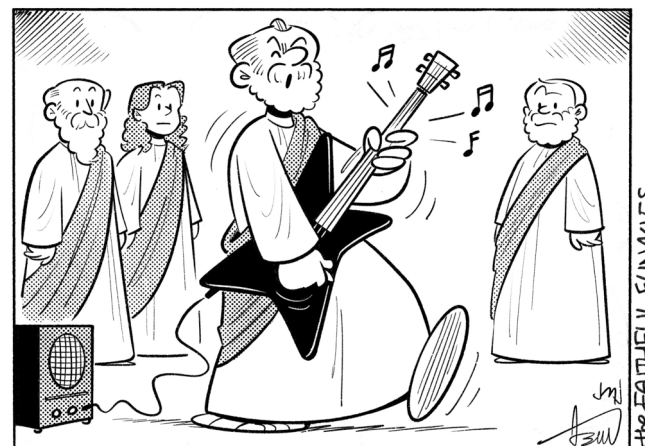

Music Ministry

Dear Parishioners,

In today's Gospel, Jesus gives us words that can sound difficult at first: "Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me." He is not telling us to love our families less. He is teaching us that every love in our life must be rooted in Him first. When Christ is first, we do not become colder toward others. We actually learn how to love them more faithfully, more patiently, and more generously.

The first reading gives us a beautiful picture of this kind of love. The woman of Shunem sees Elisha, the holy man of God, and makes room for him. She does not make a grand speech. She does not ask for attention. She simply offers hospitality. A bed, a table, a chair, and a lamp. Simple things. Ordinary things. Yet through that ordinary kindness, God brings an extraordinary blessing into her life.

This connects deeply with the Gospel. Jesus says that even giving "a cup of cold water" to one of His little ones will not go unnoticed. Sometimes we think holiness must be dramatic. We imagine that following Christ always means doing something huge. But Jesus reminds us that discipleship is often lived in small acts of love. A kind word. A meal shared. A visit. A phone call. A quiet sacrifice. A place made for someone who needs it.

At the same time, Jesus also speaks of the cross. To follow Him means that love will cost us something. It may cost us comfort, pride, time, or convenience. It may mean choosing forgiveness when we would rather hold a grudge. It may mean serving when we are tired. It may mean putting God's will before our own plans.

Saint Paul reminds us that through baptism we have been joined to Christ's death and resurrection. We are called to live in "newness of life." That new life begins when we stop living only for ourselves and begin living for God.

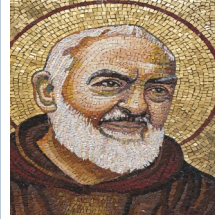
This week, we can ask a simple question: Where is Christ asking me to make room for Him? Maybe in my home, in my schedule, in my family, in my parish, or in my heart. Like the woman of Shunem, may we welcome the Lord in simple acts of faith. And like the disciples, may we take up our cross, knowing that whoever loses life for Christ will truly find it.

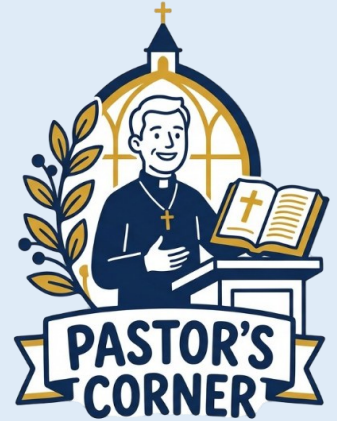

DEVOTIONS, EXPLAINED! ~PILGRIMAGE~

When the time came for the Transfiguration of Christ, Jesus took three of his disciples to "a high mountain by themselves," indicating that the sacred mysteriousness of this



moment was something best experienced apart from the routine of ordinary life. This is the principle behind the act of pilgrimage: a journey to a place of spiritual significance, undertaken by one who is seeking closeness to Heaven while still on Earth.

Christian pilgrimages really began in the fourth century, when churches in the Holy Land were constructed in locations associated with the life of Christ. Throughout the centuries, pilgrims have likewise flocked to sites of Marian apparitions, miracles, and to places connected with the lives of saints. Some of the most iconic pilgrimage destinations include Fatima, Lourdes, and the Santiago de Compostela in Spain.

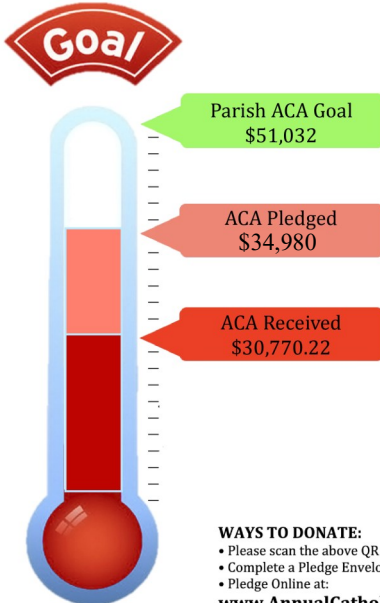

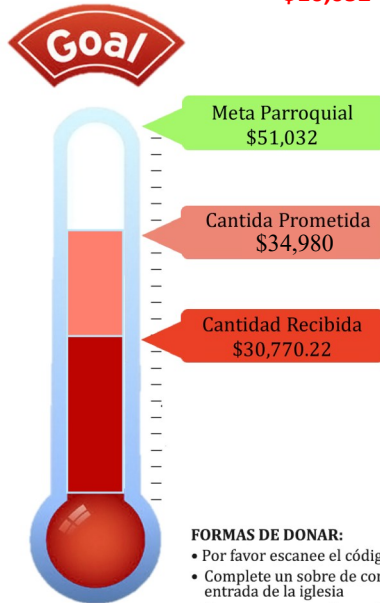
